SUMMARY

John trained at the Bartlett School of Architecture at UCL and qualified in 1971. After five years of working on educational and sports projects, he spent six years on university projects in developing countries. He returned to England in 1979 and completed a number of important public buildings including theatres, sports centres, and headquarters buildings as well as major contracts involving historic buildings. After five years of urban regeneration work in London, his interests in conservation brought him back to Somerset where he worked with practices specialising in churches and other historic buildings. He became an accredited conservation architect in 2006 and is on the approved list of architects for the Dioceses of both Bristol and Salisbury.
